Bounce into Easter

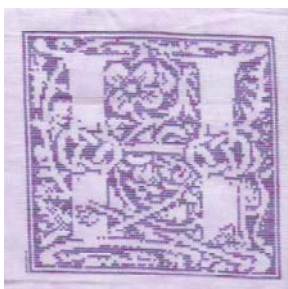
A new tuckable chart from Accents, Inc.

I've been working on this companion chart to Bunny Hop (pictured below right) for a few years and I'm so happy to say that this is the year it will bounce into our inventory. (*many thanks to Angela for prioritizing her time to get it stitched!*) It was designed to fit into an Accents pre-made pillow tuck when stitched on 14 Aida or a 28th Evenweave. The chart will be in the shop by Saturday at a retail of \$3.00; pillow tuckables are already in stock for \$9.95. The tuckable pillow serves as your "frame", but the design can also be finished as a stand-up or a standing easel (aka Flatfold) or framed. FYI there's at least one more in this series on my "to do" list.



CELTIC LETTERS

SHARING TORRIE'S GREAT GIFT WITH YOU



When we want to stitch a wedding gift today, we shy away from a traditional sampler with the names of the bride and groom. But we usually want to stitch something that will be personal and treasured for many years. The letter pictured here is from the Celtic Alphabet charts. This is a series of 12 charts, each containing 2 letters of the alphabet: A-B; C-D; etc. Each chart is \$8.50. All of the stitching is in one color, and we usually suggest an overdyed floss so that there is some variation in the coloration. Most letters are 7 inches square when stitched on a 14 Aida or a 28th Linen or Evenweave. The letter "H" (for Horton) you see here was a surprise gift to me from Torrie Sappington. She asked me to pick a fabric and a floss and now I have this beautiful letter framed and living in my bedroom where I see it everyday! How blessed I am to be on the receiving end of her stitching.
